Venue

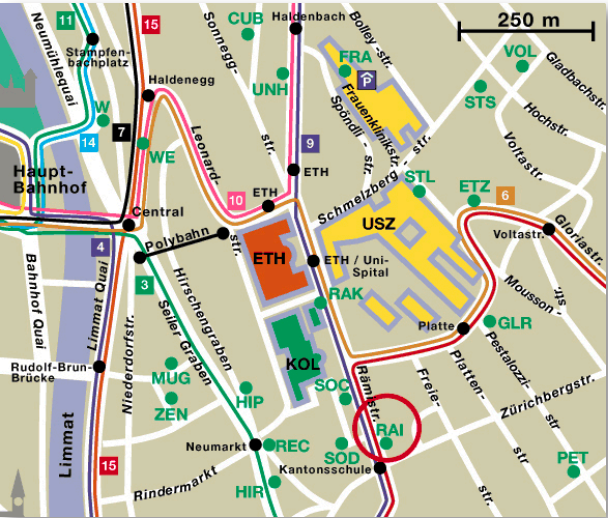
